

On first start of **PICOS-FTF** - if no other license method can be found - you will get this Login window:

Click to button **Manage Account** (1), then to **Register** (2):

Complete all fields with your company data and click to button **Register** (3).

Select an e-mail account which can be accessed by the "PICOS administrator".

This account will be used to identify your company and to enable licensed modules of PICOS-FTF.

You will get an activation code - after verification and licensing procedure by PICOS - as shown in the example on the following page.

After the registration procedure you will get an e-mail with a content like this:

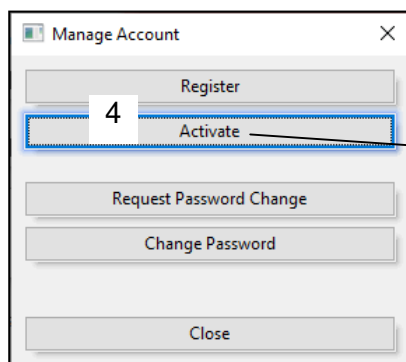
Please activate your account, by clicking the "Manage Account" button in the login dialog of your PICOS application. Then click the "Activate" button and enter this information:

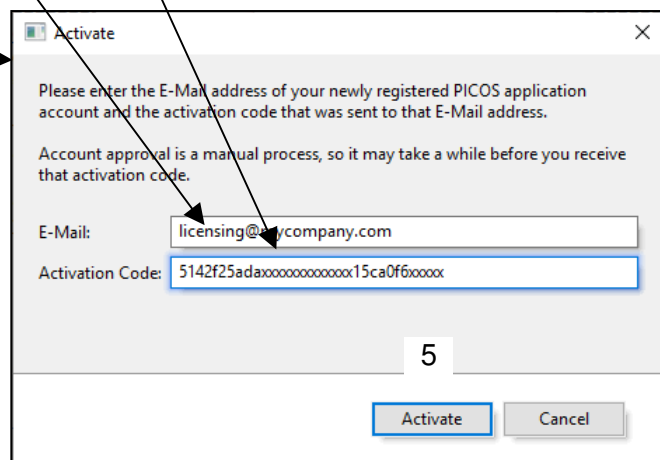
After activating your account, you can use it with your online licensing enabled PICOS applications.

Please activate your account within 72 hours, or it will be deleted automatically and you would have to go through the registration process again.

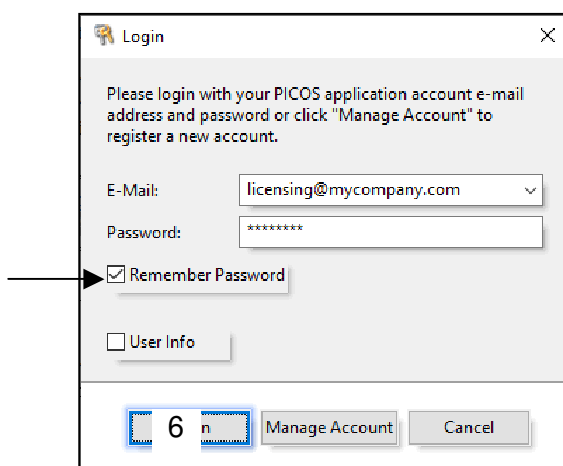
Open the Manage Account again - if closed meanwhile and click to button **Activate** (4)



Enter e-mail and activation code, then click to button **Activate** (5)



N.B: Use the copy and paste function (mark text, then right click and copy/paste)



Now login with the licensing e-mail account and the password selected above and click to button **Login** (6).

NB: Check '**Remember Password**' to avoid retyping it each time you launch PICOS-FTF.

The checkbox '**User Info**' allows to identify logged in users in a multi user environment.
